



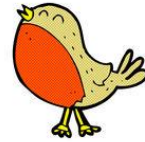
Robins News Letter

This half term our new topic is *Wriggle and Crawl*. This week we have read and learnt the story of *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* and have started to write the beginning of the story. Next week we have a special delivery arriving...our very own hungry caterpillars! We will be able to observe the changes that they will go through to become beautiful butterflies and learn about the life cycle of a butterfly.

In Science, we will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals that are birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles, mammals and invertebrates. We will also be describing and comparing the structure of these animals, along with identifying animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. After this, we will be exploring different animal habitats and investigating why animals choose to live in a particular habitat.

There will also be lots of exciting learning taking place in Art, Geography, Computing and RE!

As the Phonics Screening Check is fast approaching, we have created a *Read, Write, Inc* area in the classroom where the children can teach each other all of the sounds they need to know. The children have loved using the area this week!
