




Robins News Letter

This term our new topic is **3, 2, 1 . . . Blast Off!** For this half of the term our learning will be focused around the story *Whatever Next!* By Jill Murphy. In Literacy the children will learn the story and then innovate it to write their own version. In Art the children will draw the bear's view of space from the rocket in our story and will also paint a picture of their own rocket. We will be learning to name sources of light in Science, and will be observing the movement of the Sun during the day as well as changes across the four seasons.

In Geography we will be investigating what space is like and what people do there. We will also be using atlases, maps and globes to name the world's continents and oceans. Finally, in RE we will be learning about the festivals that Jewish people celebrate.
