SENSORY ROOM



After some training from Sadie Charlton at Virtual School about creating sensory spaces, we have transformed our little back library into a space for regulation.



Children have been accessing this room to support them to calm, to work out some wriggles and feel ready to learn and also to have a safe space when they feel unsettled. We use a sensory circuit to help meet all those sensory needs. First we get active by bouncy on the trampoline, moving on the mat or using the scooter board. Then we get our brain and body working together by balancing on the gym ball or the wobble board. After that we feed our senses with the sensory toys and the sensory wall. Finally, we calm down by focusing on our breathing. Lots of children like the dark den for this and we love the weighted snake for helping us to feel grounded.

To ensure SEND is covered in every training and staff meeting to ensure the embedding of the inclusivity for the children with additional needs.


We have been creating support documents to help staff ensure quality first teaching and adaptations are made to support all children within our classrooms.
