Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to take this opportunity to remind families of our expectations regarding the use of bikes and scooters, along with some important road safety guidance. These measures are in place to help keep all members of our school community safe.

Bikes and Scooters on School Site

- Bikes and scooters must be pushed at all times when on the school drive and premises.
- Children must wear a helmet when riding to and from school.
- Pupils are only permitted to ride to school if they have successfully completed their Bikeability course.

Road Safety Awareness

As children travel to and from school, it is important that they are reminded of safe practices when using the roads and pavements:

- Always stop, look, listen, and think before crossing the road.
- Use designated crossing points wherever possible.
- Stay alert and avoid distractions such as mobile phones or headphones near roads.
- Be visible, particularly in darker mornings or evenings, by wearing bright or reflective clothing.
- Ride sensibly and be mindful of pedestrians and other road users at all times.

We would be grateful if you could reinforce these expectations and safety messages with your child to support their wellbeing and the safety of others.
